Established in 2014, Transportation Article TR § 21-809 states the MD Police Training & Standards Commission shall develop Speed Monitoring System (SMS) Program Administrator training concerning the oversight and administration of speed monitoring program by a local jurisdiction. TR § 21-809 requires a program administrator to participate in the training program before a local jurisdiction implements a new speed monitoring program and subsequently at least once every two years.

The below action items provide relevant information on SMS regulations, and helpful resources for agency SMS program administrators. Successful review of all items below will satisfy the training requirements mandated by TR § 21-809.
